¬ The first page must have your Personal Details which includes Name, Date of birth.

Address, Hobbies, Family, Favourite book etc.

- ¬ In next page you must write a short paragraph about your Aims and Aspirations; including your strengths and weaknesses.
- ¬ A Recipe Book Tastes of Rajasthan and Assam (Art Integration)
- ¬ Creative Writing (Walking with the Excluded)

The details of the above-mentioned activities are given below. Kindly go through it thoroughly and follow the instructions given.

A RECIPE BOOK- TASTE OF RAJASTHAN AND ASSAM

A recipe book, also known as a cookbook, is a collection of recipes, instructions, and information about the preparation and serving of foods.

In this project you are supposed to choose three to four popular dishes each from Rajasthan and Assam and prepare an interesting recipe book. The main purpose of this project is to explore the difference in the kind of dishes which represent their culture, climate and tradition making them unique to their land.

- ¬ Prepare the recipe book based on your research about the popular dishes of the states.
- ¬ In your recipe book, include the following information:
- Choose a name for your book. (You can use the title given here too!)
- Create an attractive cover. (draw, be creative!)
- Plan an outline of your content.
- Divide your book into various parts, for example, source of ingredients and examples,

types of dishes, popular dishes and their recipe (Recipe must include the ingredients,

quantity of ingredients, process.)

- Research on various ingredients, style of cooking, popular dishes etc.
- Mention the uniqueness of their traditional delicacy and local specialty.
- Use images (cut-outs, drawing, small sketches etc.)
- Write in first person (imagine that you visited the place and you are sharing your experience)
